**General Rules** 

- 1. Contestants speech must relate to topic (see first page)
- 2. Contestants shall prepare orations according to grade levels and must speak on topic. The penalty for going over or under the time limit is, "three (3) points for each 15 seconds over or under the time limit."
- 3. Any quotations or copyright material used in the speech must be identified properly.
- 4. Tabernacle shall have the right to edit, publish, and record any oration entered into contest without payment to the author.
- 5. Timing begins on the first word uttered and stops on the last word.
- 6. A minimum of one minute of silence is granted to judges after an oration.
- 7. In case of a tie the judges will decide the winner based on the orator's performance.

<b>Delivery</b> - Articulation, vocal variations and gestures	25 points
Effectiveness - Clear purpose and ability to sell position	30 points
Content - Referenced facts and material substance	35 Points
Appearance - Professional attire	10 Points
Total	100 Points

Intermediate Division	3 <sup>rd</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> Grade	2-3 minutes
Middle School Division	6-8 <sup>th</sup> Grade	3-4 minutes
High School Division	9-12 <sup>th</sup> Grade	4-6 minutes
